

Video Individual Student Reports (ISRs)

Resource FAQs

1. What are video ISRs?

A video ISR is a personalized video report with a summary of assessment results for a student with a score in Math MCA, Math MTAS, Science MCA, and/or Science Alternate MCA (Alt MCA). Each video ISR includes a description of the assessment and the student’s performance in the test and subject, as well as their performance related to the school, district, and state averages. Only students with a score have a QR code to access a video ISR report included on the ISR.

School year 2025–26 is the first administration of the new Reading MCA and Reading Alt MCA and results are not available until after standard setting in the fall. Due to the delay in the release of reading results in this first year, personalized video ISRs for Reading MCA and Reading Alt MCA are not available for 2026; instead, an overview video about the new assessments is available.

2. When are video ISRs available?

The math and science personalized video ISRs, and reading overview video, are available on the same day ISRs are available to districts.

3. Who receives a video ISR?

Video ISRs are available for students with a valid score in math and/or science. Students with a non-valid score in math and/ or science (such as tests that were refused, invalidated, taken in the wrong grade, or not attempted) will not have a video ISR available.

Note: ISRs are separated by subject and test. Students will receive an ISR for each subject and test they were expected to participate in (for example, a student with math and science assessments in grade 5 receives two separate ISRs; one for math and one for science). A personalized video ISR is created for each subject with details on the student’s performance for that subject.

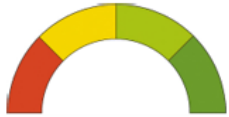

4. Are video ISRs available in other languages?

Personalized video ISRs are available in English and may be available with audio translation in another language. For 2026, personalized video ISRs may have audio translated in another language if a home language was reported to the student's school or district in one of the 10 most populous languages in Minnesota. The 10 available languages are: Amharic, Arabic, Chinese, Hmong, Karen, Oromo, Russian, Somali, Spanish, and Vietnamese.

Example 3: Alt MCA Science single subject ISR with video available with translated audio.

To access the translated video ISR, scan the QR code on the ISR to open unique link to the video ISR player. Personalized video ISRs with audio translated in another language can change the video ISR language by selecting the language in the dropdown menu on the top left of the video player webpage.

5. How do I access the video ISR?

Parents/guardians can access video ISRs by scanning a QR code on the ISR with a smart device. If parents/guardians do not have access to a smart device, they can contact their student's school for a link to the video.

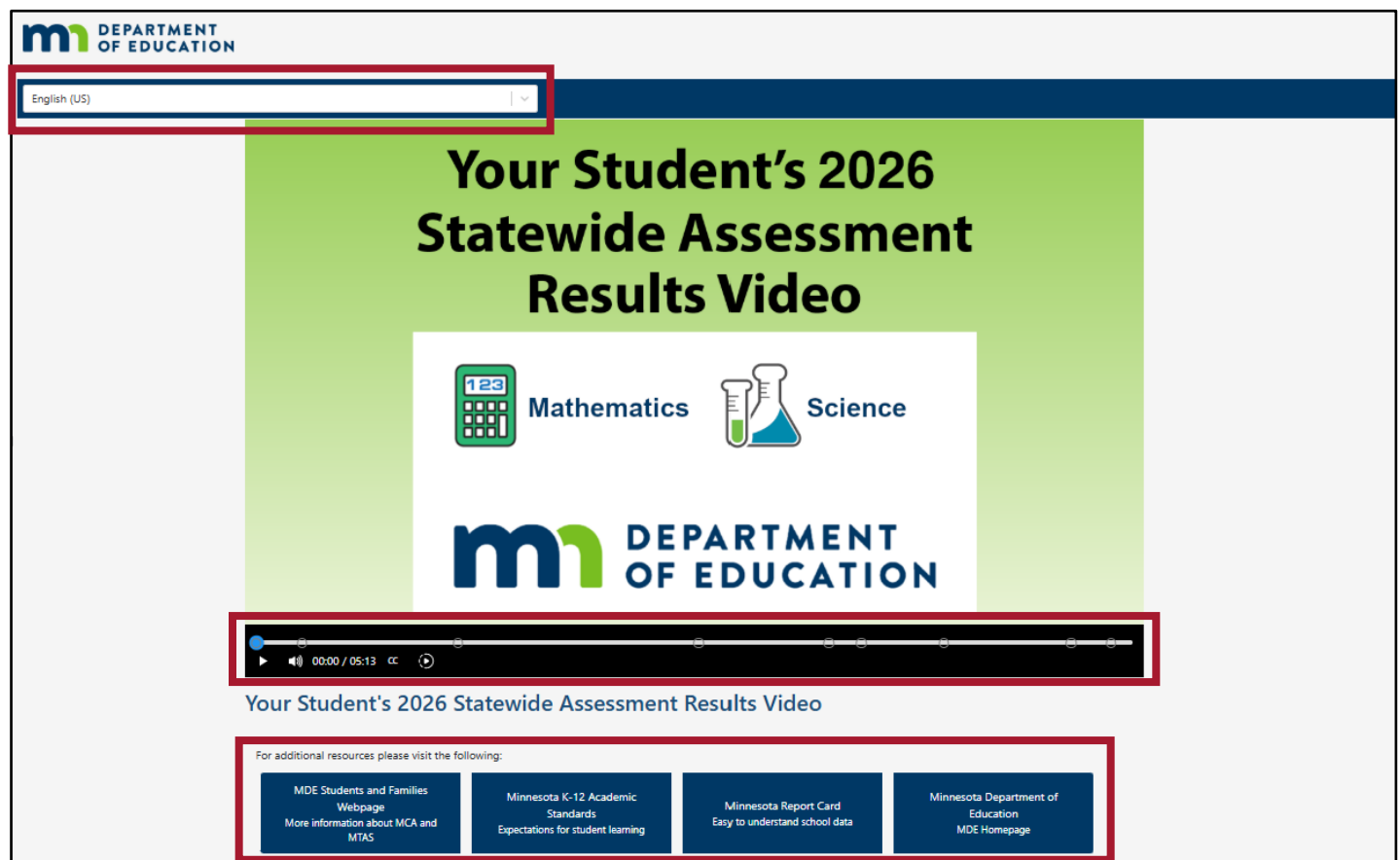
School staff with the District Assessment Coordinator (DAC) or Assessment Administrator (AA) user role in PearsonAccess Next have access to a spreadsheet containing hyperlinks of video ISRs for each student. This spreadsheet is posted by district and school and available in PearsonAccess Next under Published Reports.

Note: For Spring 2027, Pearson is transitioning test administration and reporting platforms from PearsonAccess Next to ADAM (Assessment Delivery and Management). The video ISR spreadsheet will be available in ADAM under Report Assets for DACs and AAs to download when that system goes live in fall 2026.

6. How do I watch the video ISR?

Once the QR code is scanned (or the hyperlink is entered into a browser), the video ISR opens in a browser tab. Note: The video may take a few seconds to load. Closed captioning is turned on by default. The landing page also contains links for additional resources and information.

The volume control, closed captioning button, and playback speed options are located under the seek bar. Note: When the closed captioning is turned off, the button text appears as dark grey but is still available. If a video with translated audio was indicated on the ISR, to change the video ISR translated language, select the language in the dropdown menu on the top left. Additional resources are available in boxes under the video at the bottom of the page.
